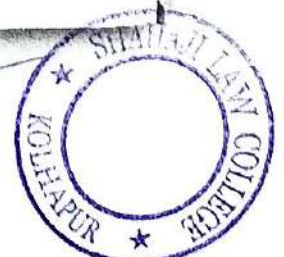

DIPLOMA IN TAXATION LAW (DTL)

I. OBJECTIVE

The tax system plays a very important role in governance of the country. Tax is the right of the government and duty of the citizens. In the context of the federal structural the distribution of the taxing powers assume added significance.

The main objective of this course is providing knowledge of the tax system in India. To impart the knowledge of the basic concepts of income tax with special reference to the Income Tax Act 1961. To equip the students with the procedure of computation of income under different heads as well as the assessment procedure of different assesses. So also to introduce the students new development in the field of taxation law and provide comprehensive and up-to-date knowledge of Taxation Law particularly new GST Act in detail.

II. Teaching Learning Methods:

Lecture method and case study method shall be the main method of learning to be followed. Visits to income tax office, income tax authorities as well as tax consultants can be arranged for better understanding of practical aspect of the subject.

III. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of the course is one year, Annual pattern, Part Time Diploma

Medium of Instruction: - English

IV. INTAKE OF STUDENTS : 60

V. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Every candidate seeking admission to the Diploma in Taxation Law Course, should have passed with 45 % marks (Open Category), 42 % marks (OBC Category) and 40 % marks (SC / ST Category) in 12th or equivalent examination from any faculty from Examining Body recognized by this University.

VI. STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE:

The Course shall be of Annual and 70 – 30 pattern

Teaching Workload 4 Lectures per paper per week. The examination shall be conducted once in a year i.e. in March / April only.

There shall be three papers having 70 Marks each -----

Paper I --- General English

Paper II --- Income Tax Act

Paper III --- Goods and Service Tax Act

VII. -- Evaluation methods: Theory Examination – 70 Marks

Internal Assessment:

Assignment / Project Work / Presentation : 20 Marks

Viva Voce College Level : 10 Marks

30 Marks

The internal viva voce examination of each paper for 10 marks shall be conducted at college level.

Total Marks = Theory 70 Marks + Internal Assessment 30 Marks = 100 Marks

VIII. NATURE OF THE EXAMINATION AND STANDARD OF PASSING:

- i) All the Question Papers of Diploma in Taxation shall be of 70 marks consists of total six questions carrying 15 marks each, out of which a student can opt any four. The seventh question shall be mandatory consisting of four short notes out of which the students have to opt any 2 out of Four having 5 marks each.
 - ii) Medium of instruction shall be English.
 - iii) The written examination will be of 3 hours duration for each paper.
- a) **Duration of Examination for each theory paper** - The duration of Term End Examination for each theory paper of 70 marks shall be of three hours.
 - b) **Standard of passing**- The Standard of passing shall be minimum 35 in each paper both theory (25 marks) + internal assessment (10 marks).

POLICE STATION VISIT

2022-2023

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INTRODUCTION

The necessity to maintain peace and keeping law and order in the society led to the establishment of law enforcing agency in the form of Police. The word "police" is derived from a Latin word "politia" which stands for state or administration. Article 246 of the Indian Constitution has made police a state subject but Delhi Police comes under concurrent list and functions under Central Government. Section 47 and 48 of Delhi Police Act empowers Commissioner of Police to remove a person out of Delhi as special power.

FOR PURPOSES OF POLICE ADMINISTRATION the Kolhapur district is under the control of the District Superintendent of Police, Kolhapur district. The district, is divided into 2 subdivisions, Northern and Southern, each incharge of a Sub-Divisional Police Officer (Assistant Superintendent of Police or Deputy Superintendent of Police). Each of these two Sub-Divisions contains nine police stations. Northern Sub-Division has eight outposts and Southern Sub-Division eleven outposts and one sub-post. The head-quarters of the Sub-Divisional Police Officers of the Northern Division is at Ichalkaranji and that of the Southern Division is at Kolhapur. Each of these Sub-divisional Officers is assisted in his work by an Inspector whose designation is Circle Police Officer. In addition, one Police Inspector in charge of Kolhapur City Police Stations is responsible for supervision over them and traffic control in the city.

For political and allied work, there is an Intelligence Branch for the whole of the district, and it is in charge of one Police Inspector assisted by one Sub-Inspector.

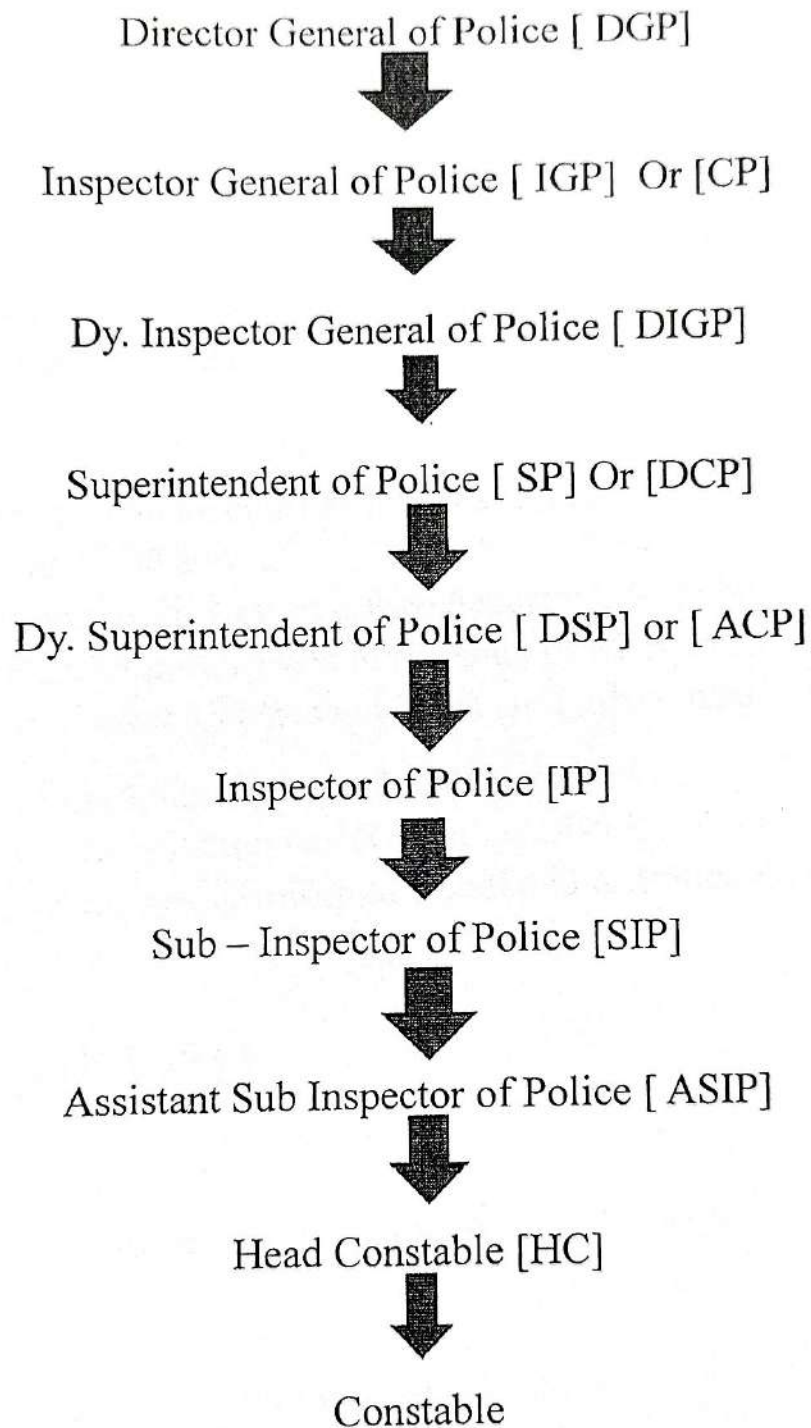
There is also a Crime Branch for the district and it is in charge of a Sub-Inspector, who is also an assistant to the Intelligence Branch.

For the recruitment and training of the subordinate police and other branches of work, there is one Inspector who is designated as Home Police Inspector. Arms, ammunition and other equipment are distributed from District Headquarters by the Reserve Sub-Inspector under the supervision of the Home Police Inspector.

To visit to Shahupuri Police Station, we came to know that they have one of the most advanced administrative system in India. The Police is undertaking the following activities –

- Preventing the crime



Central Prison, Kolhapur which was originally set up as district jail in 1950, has extensive infrastructure.

A Study visit to Kalamba Jail, Kolhapur has been held on 9th November 2022 and 10th November 2022 at 11.00 a.m.

PURPOSE OF THE VISIT

The main objectives of visit is as follows:

- ❖ To study the role of Kalamba Jail in treatment of Prisoners in the framework of rehabilitative and reformative activities given to the prisoners.
- ❖ To study the infrastructure provided by the jail authorities to the prisoners.
- ❖ To study the vision and mission of Kalamba Jail
- ❖ To study the behaviour of the inmates of the jail.
- ❖ To study the services and opportunities provided to the inmates by the jail authorities.
- ❖ To study the security system of the jail premises.
- ❖ The responsibilities of the jail authorities towards the prisoners.

INTRODUCTION

The prisons now a days are styled as a correctional institution rather than as an institution for punishment. This is because with the evolution of the society and the increasing importance of human rights we have moved into an era of reformation from the era of retribution. The main objective of prison is to convert the inmates into ordinary members of the society by providing them with useful skills, education and respect for the law.

It aims to improves the inmates self-esteem and strengthen their desire to improve. To engage, rehabilitate and reform its inmates, the current prison system in India uses music therapy which involves music training sessions and concerts. Many of the inmates continue their higher education through distance learning programmes. Thus the prison is acting as an adult school.

What is the vision of the prison department?

JAIL STRUCTURE OF MAHARASHTRA

The number of inmates in 60 jails in Maharashtra stood at 41,075 as on January 31, 2023, while the total capacity is 24,722, as per the Prison Department statistics. The statistical report for the period ending December 2021 has indicated a steady excess occupancy in jails over years. These jails include Mumbai Central Jail (446% occupancy rate), Thane Central Jail (389%), and Buldhana District Jail (387%) among others.

At 5,966, Yerawada Central Jail in Pune had the highest number of inmates as of December 31, 2021, followed by Thane Central Jail at 4,471, Mumbai Central Jail at 3,424, and Taloja Jail at 2,819.

The report stated the jail occupancy in the state was 136.19% in 2017, 148.93% in 2018, 152.72% in 2019, 128.70% in 2020 and 148.80 in 2021. In 2021, Maharashtra stood seventh in the country in terms of occupancy rate.

The average number of inmates in the total 60 jails in 2021 was 34,818, of which 96% were men and 4% were women.

As on January 31, 2023, the number of inmates in all jails was 41,075 of which 39,504 were men, 1,556 were women, and 15 were trans-genders. Of them, 7,949 were convicts, 32,917 undertrials, and 209 detainees. There were also a total of 606 foreign inmates in the jails, it said.

some prisoners have Yellow tag on their sleeves and some of the convicts have Red tag on their sleeves .

✦ **Condition of Prisoners**

We went around the wards and had interactions with some of the inmates. The wards were large halls with barred doors and windows which provide enough ventilation. They were found to be generally clean. Lights and fans were in working condition. The condition of toilets inside was satisfactory. Drinking water was available. It was mentioned that the inmates are also provided all essential items of daily use like clothing, linen, blankets, mat, towels, soaps etc.

BASIC AMENITIES

✦ **Water supply and sanitation**

It was mentioned that pipe water is being supplied to the jail. As far as sanitation facilities are concerned every barrack has a cage toilet. Adequate number of toilets are available for the use of prisoners. Water was available in the toilets. Toilets were generally clean and well maintained. Bathing space is also adequate.

✦ **Power Supply**

24 hour power supply is available in the jail. A generator is installed as back up.

✦ **Food Supply**

The jail has a modern kitchen which is centrally located. It is very large and spacious and appeared to be in good condition. Ventilation is available. Exhaust fans are fitted on the walls. Tap water supply is available for cooking, washing and cleaning purposes. Pipeline gas supply is available for cooking.

Food is reportedly being cooked for prisoners in kitchen. chapatis are said to be prepared here on daily basis. It was mentioned that the inmates are provided three main meals, including breakfast, lunch and dinner. A variety of diet is reportedly provided. Tea, milk and bananas are also being supplied. Food supplied is on calorie basis. Food served to the prisoners appeared to be satisfactory.

100 prisoners work in two shifts in the kitchen. Vegetables for use in the kitchen are produced in kitchen gardens maintained in the jail campus.

- Progress in individual cases also needs to be tracked.
- Data on appeals filed by prisoners ought to be maintained properly.

Jail authorities ought to make a sustained efforts to reduce UT populations, by increased production of UTs through video-conferencing, proper tracking of cases, providing legal aid to UTs, regular organization of Lok Adalat and getting petty cases disposed of etc.

Parole and Furlough

In Maharashtra Parole is sanctioned to prisoners as per provisions of the Bombay Prison [Furlough and Parole] Rules, 1959, and amended as Maharashtra Prison [BF & P] Rules, 2015. It is seen that the Rules were last amended on 26-8-2016.

In the state, parole is sanctioned by Divisional Commissioners under rule 18[2] of the above said rules and the appeal against rejection rests with the State Government. Furlough is sanctioned by the DGP concerned, and emergency parole of 15 days by the Jail Superintendent.

Applications for grant of parole are to be filed by the prisoners under rule 19. Grounds permissible for sanction include serious illness or death of close relatives, damage of houses in natural calamities and marriages of close relatives.

❖ Incarceration of women

Some have small children with them; often they are separated from their small children and sometimes they are the only bread winners of their families. Detention of women, therefore, should be on exception rather than rule. If they are detained, they ought to be provided assistance to secure bail. Many of them are illiterate. They ought to be supported with legal aid and legal counselling, on priority. Their cases ought to be monitored individually. They also need to be helped to file appeals, if convicted.

❖ Right to Health

Central Prison, Kolhapur has jail hospital for Health care of its inmates

❖ Jail Capacity

Against a sanctioned approximate capacity of 1700 occupancy reported was approximately 2100 in Central Jail, Kolhapur.

❖ Living Conditions

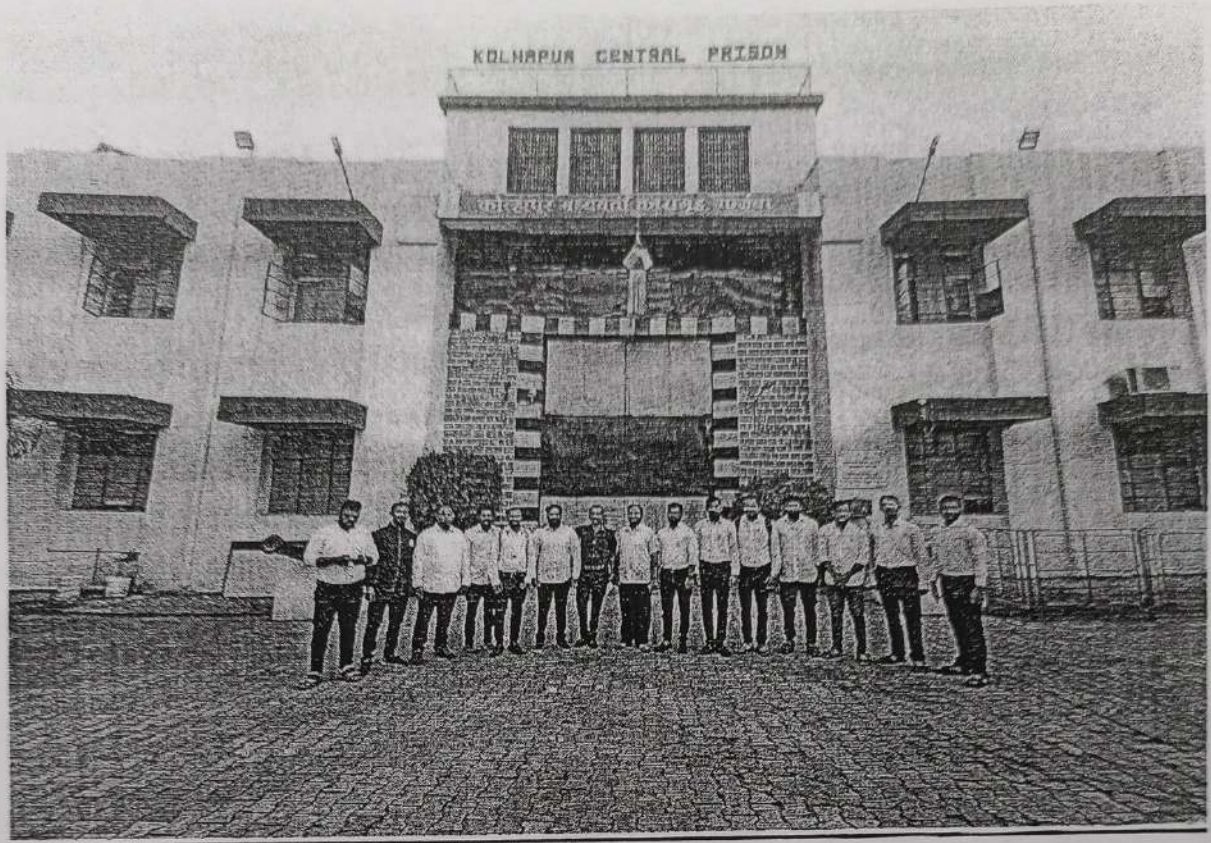
In prisons barracks were in found to be in good condition. Basic facilities like drinking water, regular power supply, bathing and toilet facilities are available to inmates in jails. Articles of daily use have also been provided. Food supply appeared to be generally satisfactory.

❖ Access to justice

Easy access to justice is one of the most important rights of prisoners. Prisoners in various prisons often complain about lack of legal support, difficulty in getting police escort, non – production before courts, cases not being taken up and undue delay in receiving judgements etc. Had the legal support system been effective, so may UTs would not have remained in jail, that too far years together. As of these pandemic period only 40 % of the under trials could be produced before courts in central Jail Kolhapur.

- Non- sanctioning of legal aid is a violation of the orders of the Supreme Court which held that legal aid to a poor is a constitutional mandate not only by virtue of Article 39A, but also Articles 14, 19, 21 which cannot be denied by the government.
- Although legal aid is sanctioned to prisoners, it is generally seen taken up in a routine fashion. Women, especially with children, prisoners belonging to SC/ ST communities and other vulnerable sections, which include BPL / elderly prisoners ought to get priority.
- The impact of providing legal aid is not seen assessed.
- Most often prisoners, especially women, have no knowledge of the stage at which their cases were pending. A system for tracking / monitoring of cases should be put in place quickly.
- It is learned that video- conferencing facility is being utilized in prisons. Attention needs to be paid on efficiency of daily production and the quality of time spent by each prisoners before the courts.
- Cases relating to elderly prisoners, female prisoners with children need to be scrutinized quickly, to find out the extent of their involvement and for taking remedial measures.
- Legal Service Authority ought to be made more active.

INSPECTIONS AND SECURITY

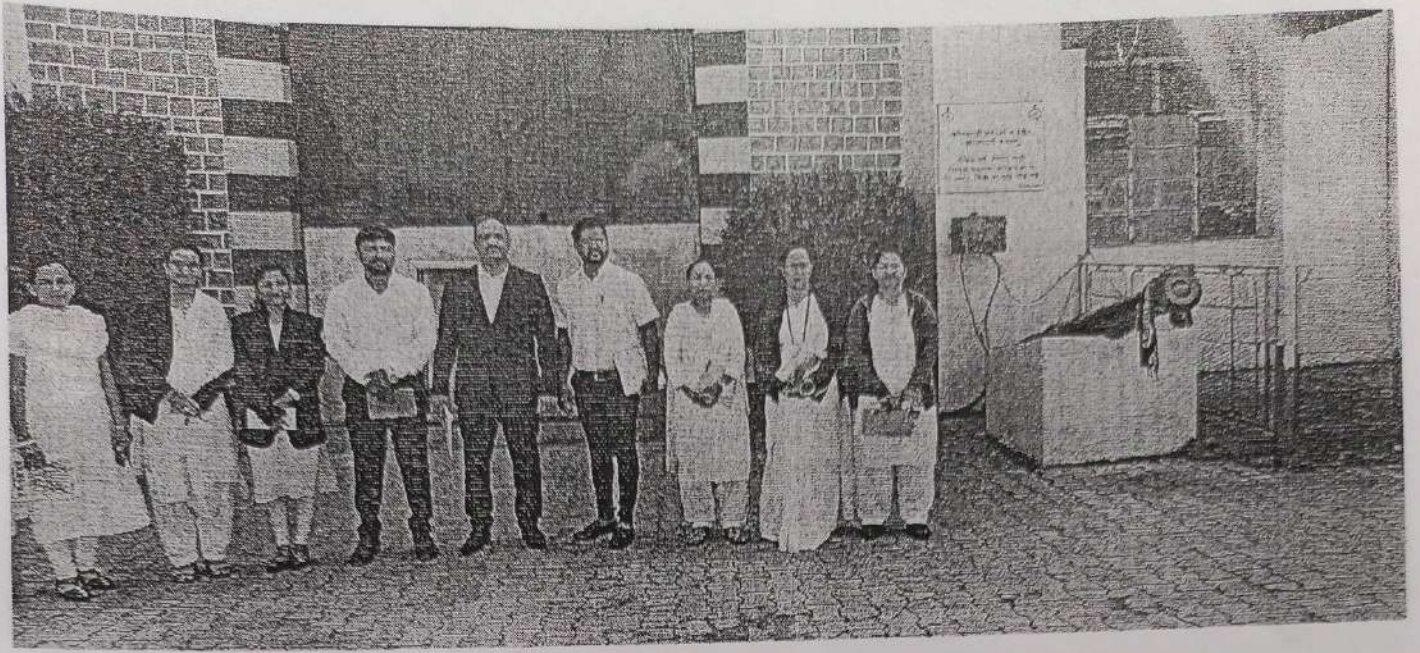
It was stated that regular inspections are conducted by IG [prisons], DIG [prisons] and other senior officials. District Judge and CJM visit the jail regularly.

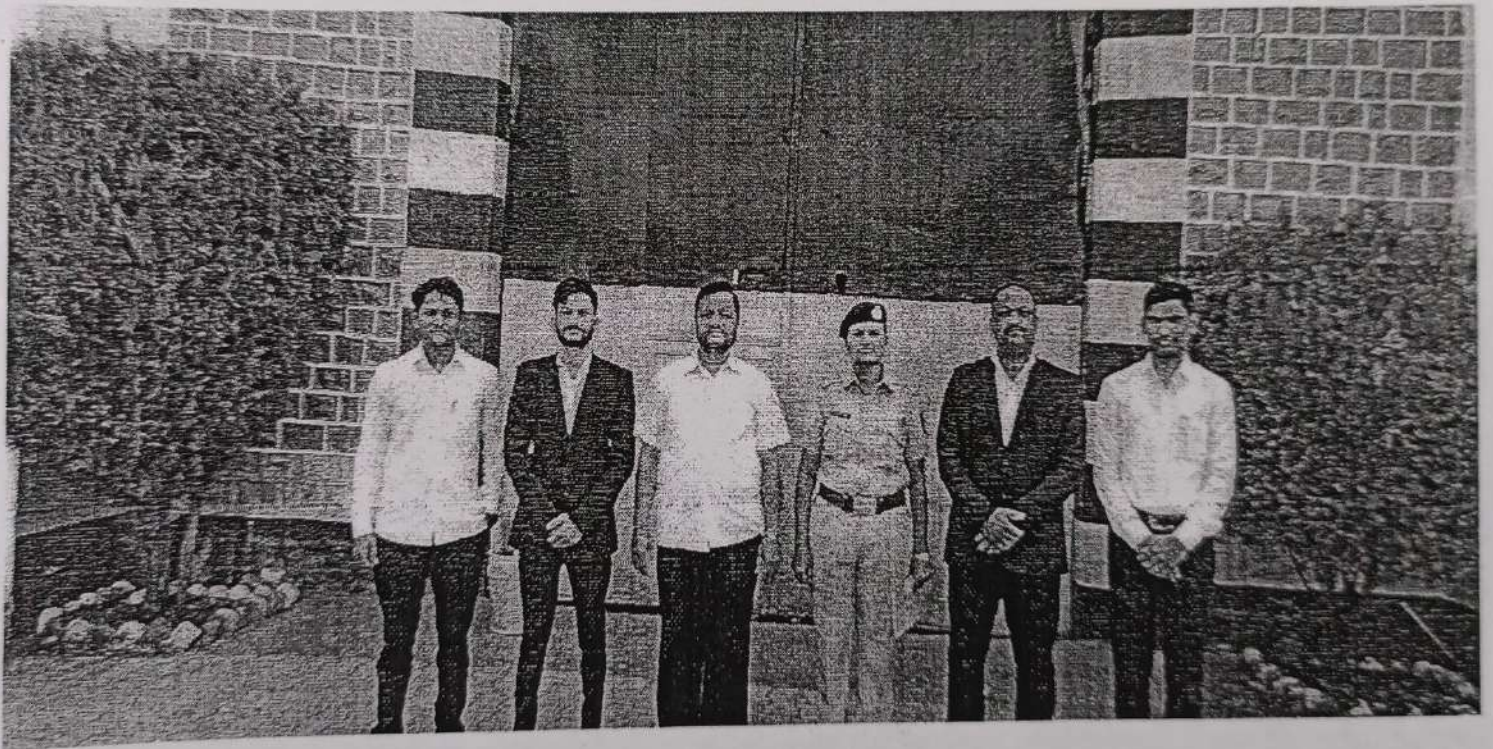
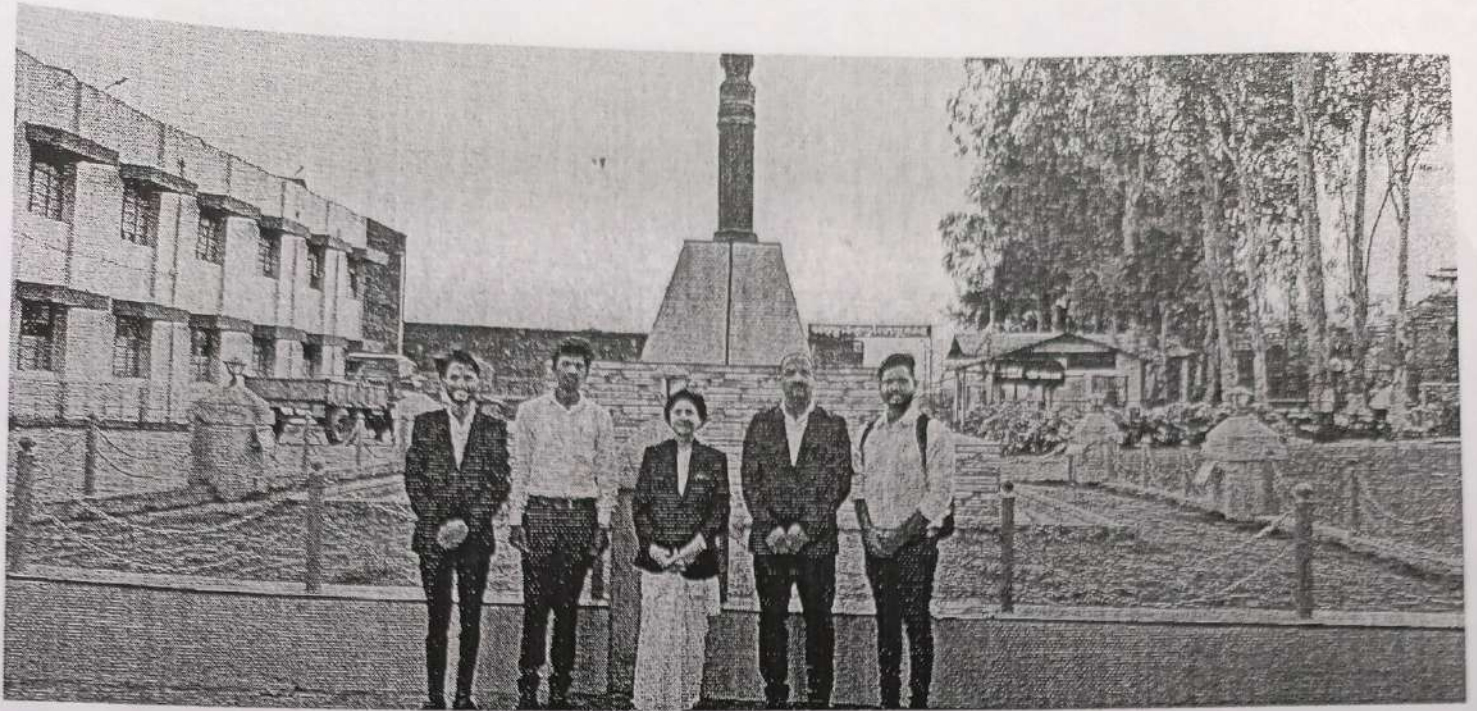
Jail authorities claimed that the jail had necessary modern equipment including VHF units, door frame metal detector, hand held metal detector, deep search metal mine detector, mobile jammer, 59 CCTVs have been installed in all barracks, circle areas, hospital and high security area for manning which an office has been set up. A separate officer and jail constables are meaning this unit, 25 walkie-talkies have also been provided for controlling and maintaining security in the jail. It is learned that out of sanctioned posts of 108 security staff [Sepoys] only 91 are filled up ; out of 16 posts of Hawaldar, only 13 are filled up. Only 03 posts of Subedar are filled up [3/6]. Security of the prison ought to be reviewed from time to time by higher authorities.

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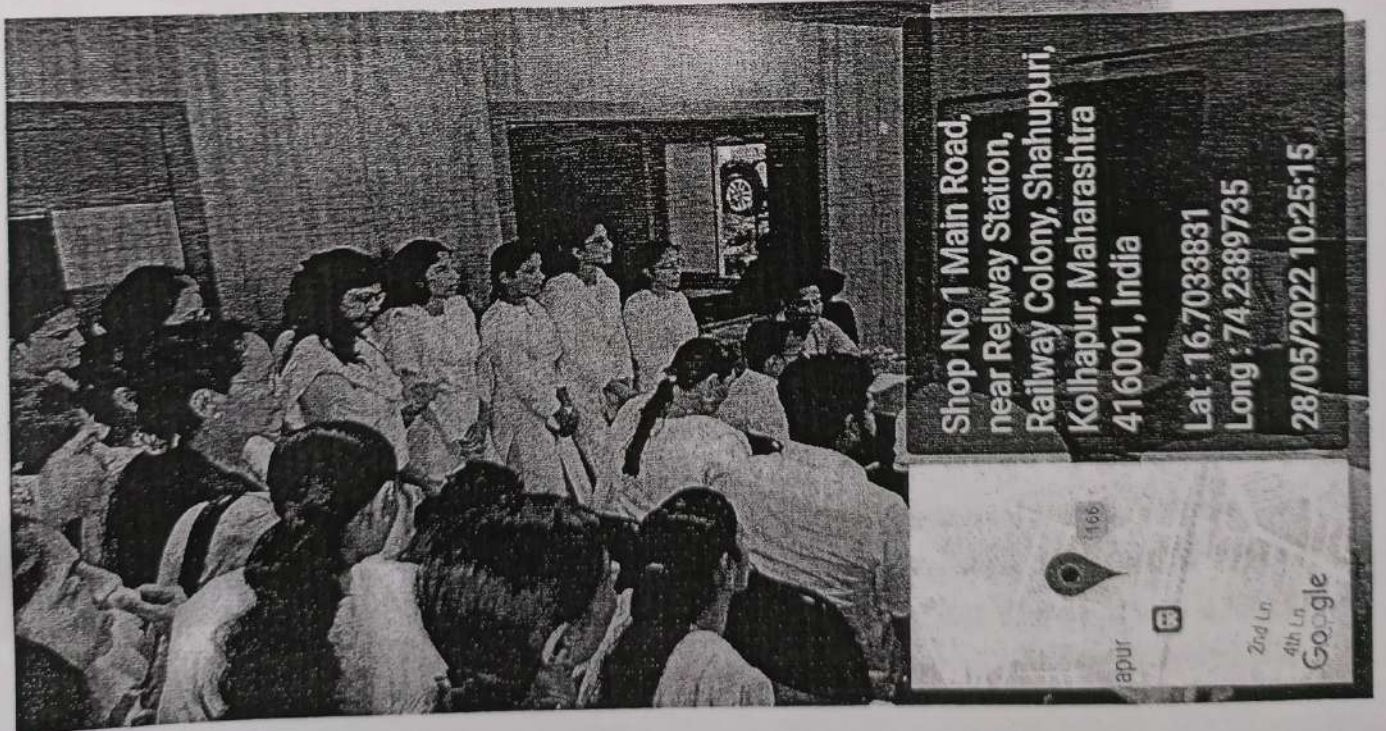
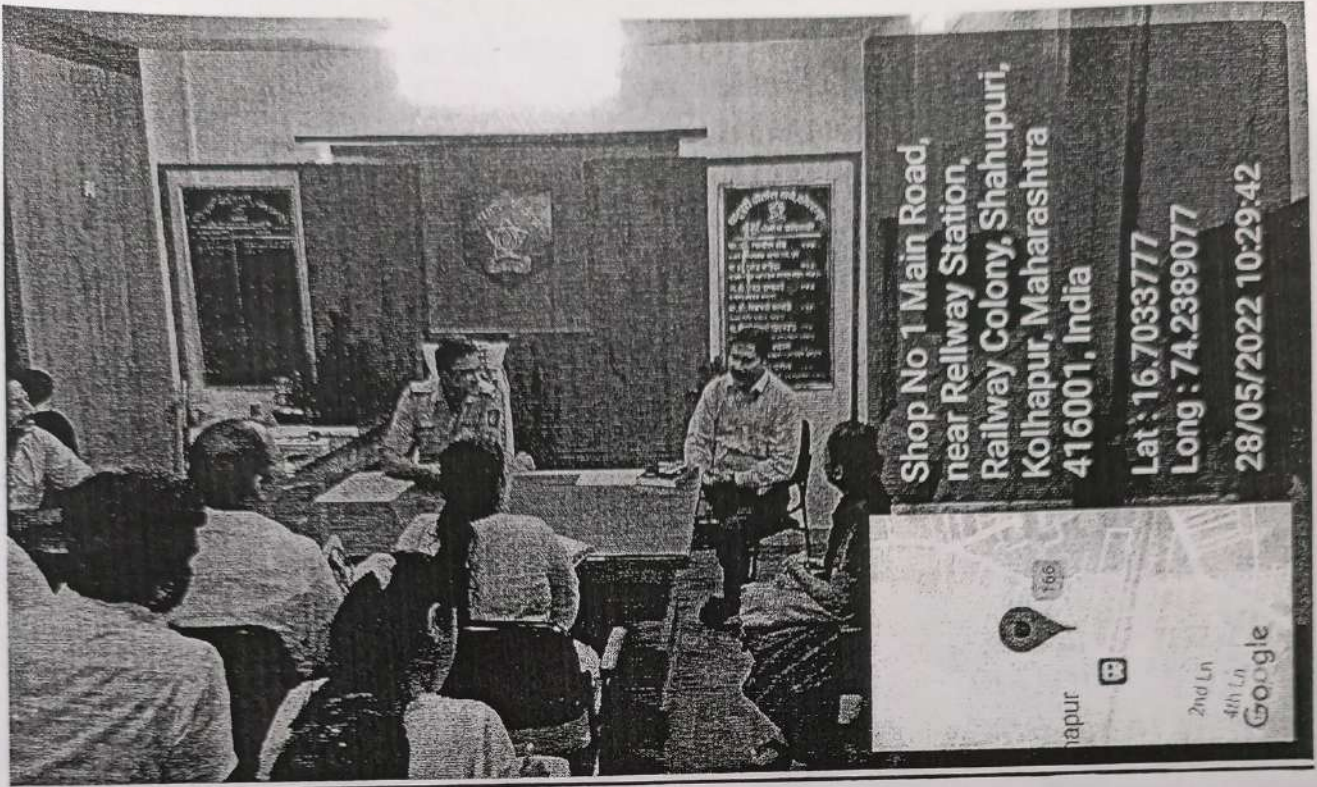

Whereas in the Model Police Act, Superintendence of the police vests in the relevant state government. The state government is responsible for ensuring an efficient, effective, responsive and accountable police service. Superintendence is limited to promoting "professional efficiency of the police" and ensuring that "[police] performance is at all times in accordance with law. Administration of the police vests in the Director General of Police. The government cannot interfere with the Director General's powers except in accordance with prescribed rules or in exceptional circumstances (where reasons should be recorded). The powers of administration will include:

- supervising the functioning of the police at all levels;
- appointment to subordinate ranks (all officers below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police);
- deployment;
- transfers and disciplinary action up to and inclusive of the rank of Inspector of Police; and
- advising the government on the placement of officers of and above the rank of Assistant/Deputy Superintendent of Police.

INFORMATION IN COGNIZABLE CASES:- (as in section 154 of the Code of Criminal Procedure)

- (1). Every information relating to the Commission of a cognizable offence, if given orally to an officer-in-charge of a Police Station shall be (a). reduced to writing by him, or (b). under his direction, be read over to the informant (complainant), and (c). shall be signed by the person giving the information (complaint).
- (2). The substances of the First information shall be entered in the general diary.
- (3). A copy of the First Information Report form shall be given to the complainant forthwith.
- (4). The complainant, if aggrieved, by the refusal by the Station House Officer to record the first information report may send his complaint in writing by post to the Superintendent of Police concerned who may, if satisfied, investigate the case himself or direct any Police officer subordinate to him to investigate the case. Are some provisions for police.



STRUCTURE OF KALAMBA JAIL

✦ Profile of the district

With a population of 3,876,001 [2011 census] Kolhapur is the largest district in Maharashtra in terms of population. It is situated on the western part of Maharashtra and shares a boarder with Belgaum district of Karnataka to the south.

✦ Crime Profile of the district

As per report of National Crimes Record Bureau of [NCRB] 2013, with a record of 4800 crimes, Kolhapur district in Maharashtra stood 151st in all crime record of India. It reported a crime rate of 123.84 compared to National Crime rate 218.67 in 2013. It stood 79th in no of murders, 61st in no of rapes, 25th in no of robberies, 70th in no of thefts, 26th in no of dacoities, 174th in no of kidnappings and 41st in no of riots.

✦ Jail Profile and History

As mentioned for the purpose of prison administration, the state of Maharashtra is divided into four Divisions-Eastern, Western, Northern, and Southern, each headed by a DIG, Kolhapur forms a part of the Western region.

Originally set up as District Prison before the formation of Maharashtra state, Central Prison, Kalamba, Kolhapur is one of the largest prisons in Maharashtra. The prison had housed many freedom fighters during the British period. On the other hand, some of those who belong to dreaded criminal gangs and those allegedly involved in Bombay blast and Railway blast, prisoners from Mumbai, Kalyan, Sangli, Satara, Karad, Ratnagiri, Sholapur and some from outside the state are serving their sentence here.

✦ Land and infrastructure

The prison is spread over an area of 73.36 acres with a built up area of 15.10 acres. It also has an open jail presently accommodating 43 prisoners.

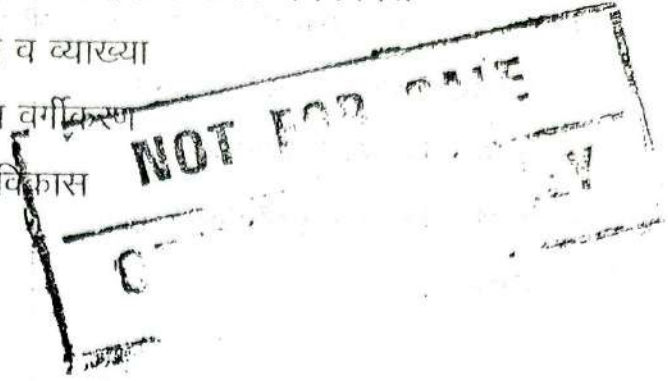
The jail infrastructure comprises of 36 barracks and 91 cells in all. 11 are High Security Cells. For the purpose of administration the prison is divided into Circles. Circles no. 1-8 comprises of 29 barracks and 53 cells for housing male prisoners. The hospital yard had 02 barracks and 20 cells. Women's enclosure has two barracks and 06 cells ; Juvenile circle [19-25 years] two barracks and 12 cells and the kitchen yard only one barrack.

PHYSICAL OBSERVATION

The police station in which we visited is located in Shahupuri. This police station covers the area of Shahupuri. Two or three cases registered in this police station in a day. There is a board in which the poster of criminals with their details is printed. A notice board for officer's direction is also located. Different registers are maintained for different things. If a complaint is comes then try to find the truth that the complaints is true or false.

As we entered the gate of police station, we found that the ground floor consisted of following section.

1. Reception –

On the left hand as we entered the main gate inside the station, there was a reception which consisted of a big wooden table. It was headed by a lady constable. It is a place from where the complaint is directed to the respective duty officer. No FIR is lodged in this section but only the entries are done.

2. Duty Officer –

Duty officer is a person who lodges the FIR and tells the respective officer about the report. He maintains the daily diary and puts entry in them. In case of cognizable offence, he lodges FIR [First Information report] while an NCR [Non Cognizable Report] is filled in case of non cognizable offences. He also maintains the PCR calls.

3. Investigation Room –

There is a room in the police station where a person whether accused or witness can be detained for some time by the investigation officer for enquiring.

4. Record Room –

All files are maintained here. The record of various offences and there details, PCR call record, bail register, FIR record and other information are maintained here.

The registers are given no. and designated by those no. only for example conviction record is maintained in register no. 5 , criminal record is maintained in register no. 9

What is meant by FIR

The essential point of filling of FIR is to set criminal law into action, and not to state all the minute details there in. A First Information Report [FIR] is the first step in a criminal case record by the police.

It includes :

- The basic knowledge of the crime committed
- Place of commission
- Time of commission
- Who was the victim etc.

The Shahupuri police station was visited to understand the proceedings of FIR. It was a working day and the police men welcomed us. They treated us well and gave details of the FIR and its steps.

- First Information Report [FIR] is a written documents set by the police when they get information about the commission of an offence. It is an account of information that reaches the police first, and that is why it is called the First Information Report.
- A copy of the FIR is provided to the accused.
- FIR is filed only for cognizable offences [Those offences in which police do not require any warrant to arrest]. The police have the right to arrest the accused person and investigate into the matter.
- If an offence is not cognizable, the FIR is not filed and in this case, the act is not possible without the intervention of the court.
- FIR for Cognizable [serious] Offences have been defined u/s 2[c] of the Cr.P.C. 1973. This is the class of offences in which the police has the authority to make an arrest without a warrant. These offences are serious in nature, and thus the aim is to avoid the criminal or accused of harming others. Hence the police have been given right to make an arrest without warrant.

5. Police Maalkhana –

It is one of the most important parts of police station. This room is a place where the various types of items collected for example – shoes, clothes, weapons, or other things. These items collected from the place of crime. These items are maintained for further trial. These items send to Forensic labs for testing.

6. Computer Room –

The FIR is now recorded in computerized form after the year of 2007. And all the data of police station saved on his website. This website is police personal website.

7. Wireless Room –

The call is directed from the headquarter to the wireless room of the police station. When a crime commits then the headquarter inform in police station through the wireless in which area the crime commits.

8. Police Lock-Up –

There are separate lock-ups for male and female. It is two in number. A proper sanitation facility is there. Rooms have sanitation facilities but no switchboards or fans, nails or any sharp edges which might help to commit suicide or harem themselves in any form.

Preparation of Case Diary U/S 172 Cr.P.C.

Case diary is also called as C.D. which contains all the investigating details. It has two kinds of pages as inner case diary and outer case diary. Inner case diary used as supplement copy and investigation proceedings are has done, up to dating by day to day in the outer case diary. These diaries are a relevant part of the case file which has F.I.R., statement of accused, inner case diary, outer case diary, disclosure statement, if any medical reports spot memo and is regularly updated by the concerned I.O. [Investigation Officer].

Some Penal Provisions

Under the Indian Constitution, the Police are a state concern. However, there are similarities between the states, due to three main reasons. First, all state polices are structured and regulated by the Police Act of 1861 or they have state statutes that are modelled after the 1861 Act. Second, the India Police Service is trained, recruited and managed by the central government. The service also deploys the senior offices to the states. Third, the central government maintains a coordinating role, while the state government is in charge of supervising its police force.

At the district level (every state is divided into districts), there is a level of dual control. On the one hand, there is a high-ranking police officer in charge of the district (District Superintendent of Police). On the other hand, that District Superintendent is subject to the general direction and control of the District Magistrate, who belongs to the executive. This was done so as to assure executive rule over the police, which was considered essential for maintaining British rule. However, the system was not always efficient so it was supplemented, gradually, in many cities, with another system, by which the commissioner of police supervises that area. Matters relating to the police at the central level are under the responsibility of the Ministry of Home Affairs.

The relationship between the state and the central government is complex and multifaceted, regulated by the Constitution and framework statutes. However, for our purposes, it is important to establish which entity has control over police conduct itself. The police itself are under the auspices of the Ministry of Home Affairs. And yet, the mechanism which checks police conduct is not to be found there. The police does investigate official misconduct and corruption, but only when it comes to the misconduct of other government officials and not to police misconduct itself.

In terms of internal disciplinary investigations, the police are responsible for disciplining their own.

The duties of the police are specified in the Police Act of 1861, a remnant of colonial rule that was designed to be highly militaristic and authoritarian.

Section 20 specifies that the police do not have unfettered discretion to commit any act, but only those acts that have been sanctioned by law (the ultra-vires principle). Section 23 specifies the general duties of the police officer. Save for a brief section on neglect of duty, however, the Act does not discuss instances of civilian and political control over police when the latter has exceeded or abused its power.

Under the Police Act 1861, the superintendence of the police vests in the State Government and it is exercised by the State Government to which the Police Officer is Subordinate. The administration of the Police according to the act vests in the Inspector-General of Police and in such Deputy Inspectors-General and Assistant Inspector-General, as the State Government considers fit.

Part D: Spelling Quiz(Homophones and pamoym) SWOT Analysis, Describing objects and Instruments, Pick at random , Group Discussion , Art of Public Speaking, Drafting a virtual message.

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Based on the test results, all the students were grouped into four levels as shown in the following table.

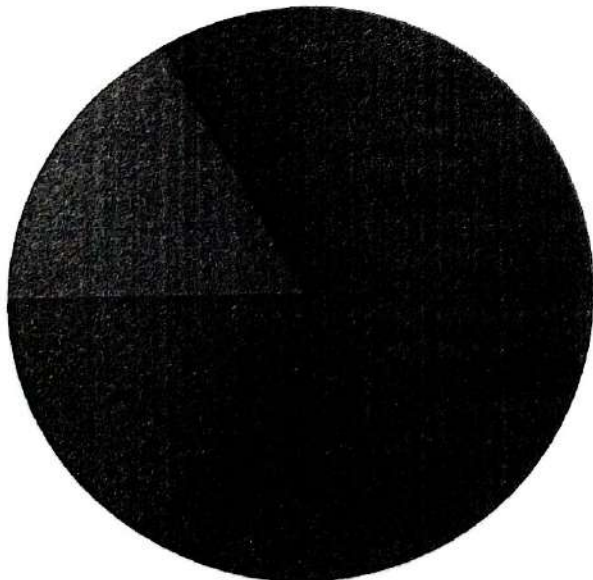
