While listening to the Criminal matters, we obtained information about the Case type, Stage of case, Case Number, Warrant Case, & Procedure for applying for Anticipatory bail etc. We also understood how to take adjournment date and also learnt the stages of disposing matter of Criminal proceeding.

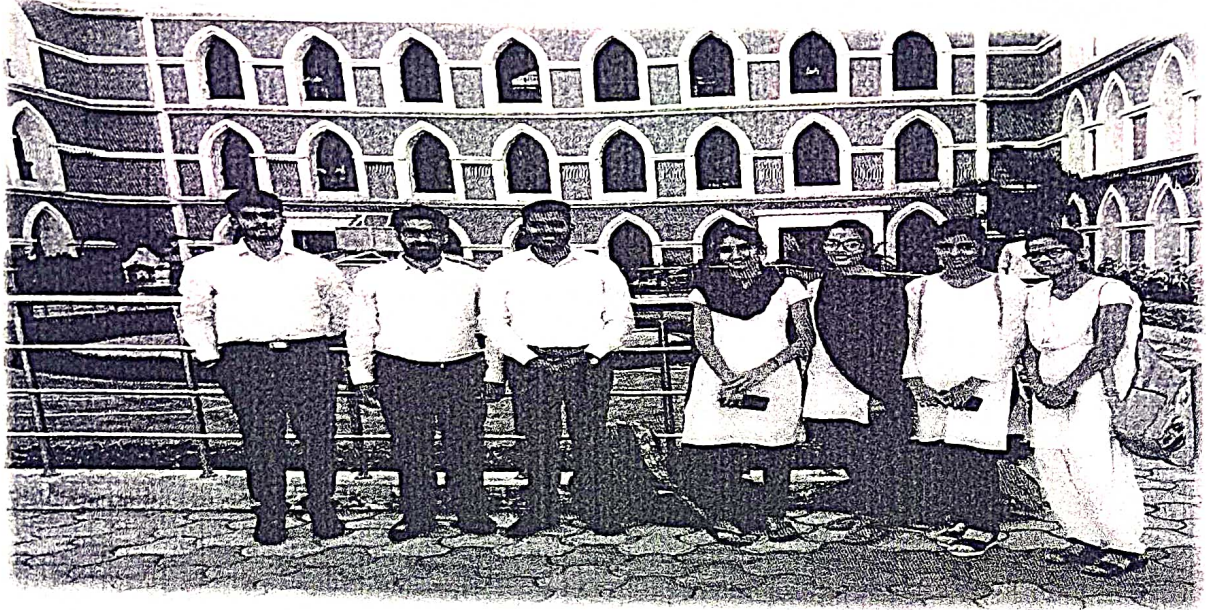

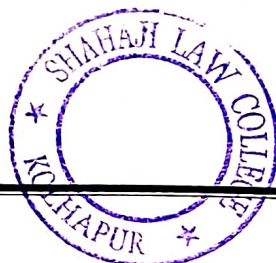

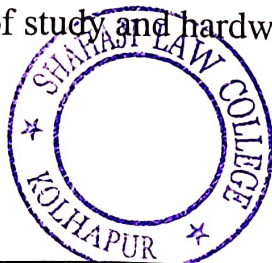
Firstly, Shri A. A Laulkar Sir gave a speech on the topic of Moot Court.

After that we had a conversation with Justice Dr. Agnihotri we told them that we are law students we are here for Court attendance and observation. He said that "A good Advocate is one who has patience & Experience."

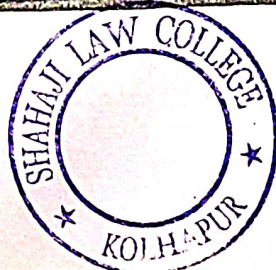

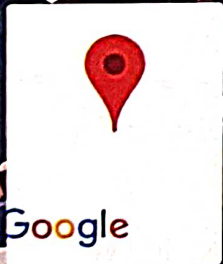
REPORT ON DLSA VIST

- Date: 4th October 2022
- Place: District Sessions Court, Kolhapur
- Topic: Visit to DLSA
- Speaker: Mr. Pritam Patil (Senior Division Judge)

On the 4th of October 2022, we, the students, visited the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA), where the Secretary of DLSA and Senior Division Judge, Mr. Pritam Patil, provided us with a comprehensive overview of the operations of DLSA. The primary aim and function of DLSA are to provide free and competent legal aid, including counseling and legal advice, as well as free legal services for cases presented before courts and tribunals. Mr. Pritam Patil emphasized that DLSA primarily engages in coordination, mediation, arbitration, conciliation, and negotiation, with no involvement in judicial proceedings.

Additionally, DLSA organizes Lok Adalats four times a year to facilitate easy communication. Mr. Pritam Patil also informed us that in cases involving POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offenses) violations, DLSA provides compensation to the victims. If the victim is a minor, DLSA creates a fixed deposit (FD) in the

victim's name, allowing them to access the funds upon reaching the age of majority for future use. To date, DLSA has disbursed compensation ranging from 1.50 to 2 crore rupees to victims. This insightful session provided us with a comprehensive understanding of how the District Legal Services Authority operates.

We the student of Shahaji Law College, Kolhapur to know well the working and purpose of Lok Adalat visited Family Court Lok Adalat on 11th Dec. 2021.

First we all take permission from family court, Kolhapur and on 11th Dec. presented their to attend Lok Adalat.

Lok Adalat is one of the alternative dispute redressal mechanisms, it is a forum where disputes / cases pending in the court of law or at pre-litigation stage are settled / compromised amicably. Lok Adalats have been given statutory status under the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987.

We were divided in two groups to maintain decorum of court. We sat there seen the actual working of Lok Adalat. There were various types of cases. First case which we seen was of Suresh Kambale v/s Tejaswini Mane. They were husband and wife. Facts of the case were that both these Husband and wife lived together only 15 days. After that 3 years they lived separately because of some miscellaneous reasons. After hearing the facts

Hon'ble Judge Agnihotri ma'am and other two panel advocates were suggested to file this matter to arbitration.

Another case was related to Restitution of Conjugal Rights. Parties of the case were Soniya Patange vs Nilkanth Patange. It was settled matter in Lok Adalat. There are some cases, were which were for divorce petition.

As like that we know very well the importance of Lok Adalat. A Lok Adalat can decide disputes where the law permits a compromise or settlement between individuals.

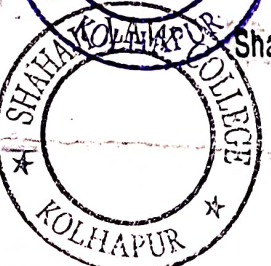
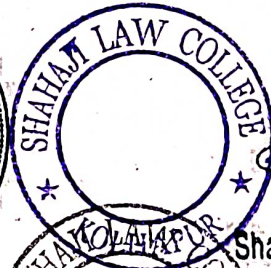
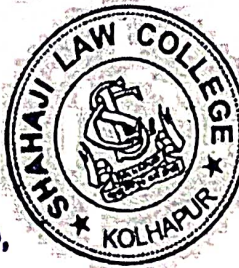

The founder of this NGO is 'Patole' family. The founder and co-founder of the NGO co-operated with us from the beginning to an end.

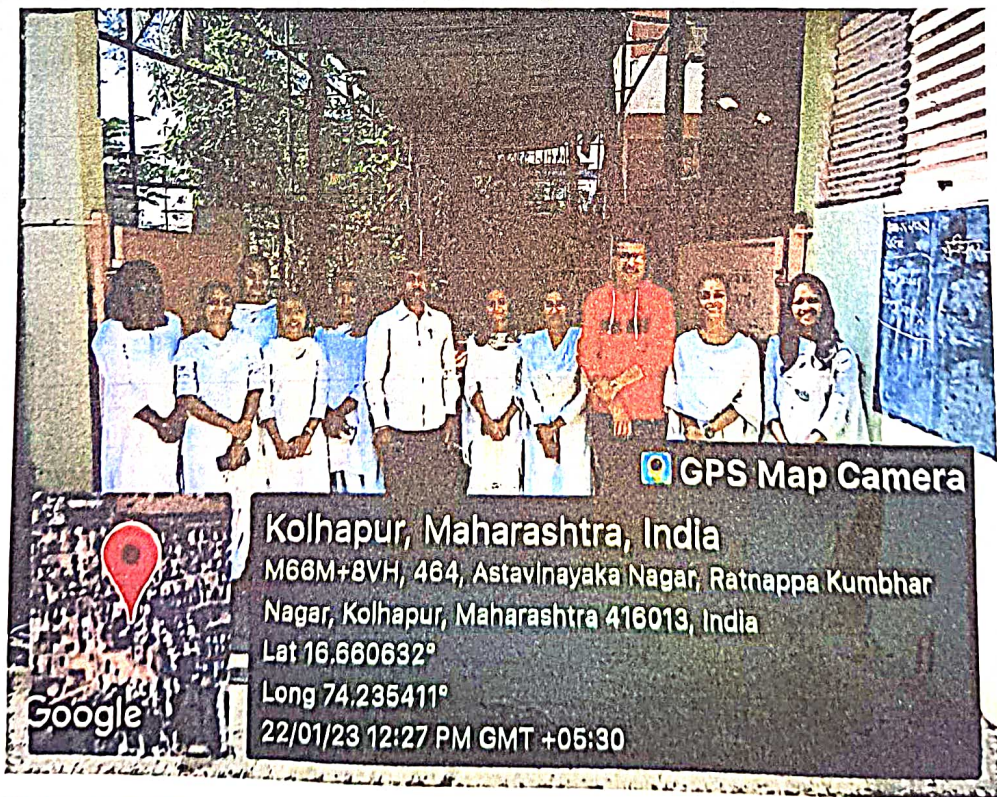



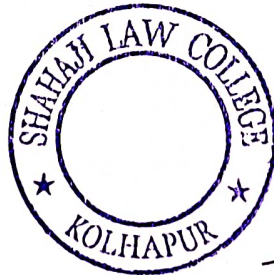

Crime detection work- The crime detection job profile would include:

- (a) collection of information/intelligence about criminals of various types and taking notes from the CIG.
- (b) Creation of mukhbirs/informers and creating contacts with the members of criminal tribes and other segments of society so as to obtain useful information with regard to the detection of various property and other offences like murder, dacoity, robbery etc.

Collection of Intelligence -Police are required to collect intelligence about:

- a) any incident of law and order
- b) political activities
- c) labour activities
- d) student activities and agitations thereof
- e) communal tensions and events
- f) employees' associations and strikes by them
- g) criminal activities
- h) miscellaneous activities and events tending to destroy peace and tranquility.

Maintenance of Police Records-This would include:

- (a) proper handling of the record
- (b) upkeep and maintenance of the record
- (c) preparation, destruction, revision and modification of the record of various police units

Assistance to other departments, this would include assistance to

- (a) the education department during examinations, students, and employees' strikes and other situations of disorder,
- (b) the revenue department and loaning organizations for recovery of loans revenue collection etc.,
- (c) the departments like banks and municipalities for guards etc for the removal of encroachments etc, and
- (d) the other departments as and when the need arises.

Miscellaneous duties and functions

This would include:

- a) ceremonial duties
- b) discharging regulatory duties and regulation of traffic and traffic management duties.
- c) comprehension of the norms of loyalty, commitment, neutrality and impartiality in the discharge of one's functions

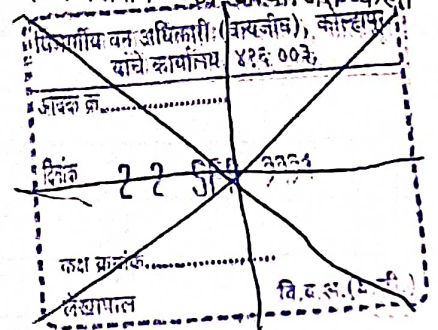


