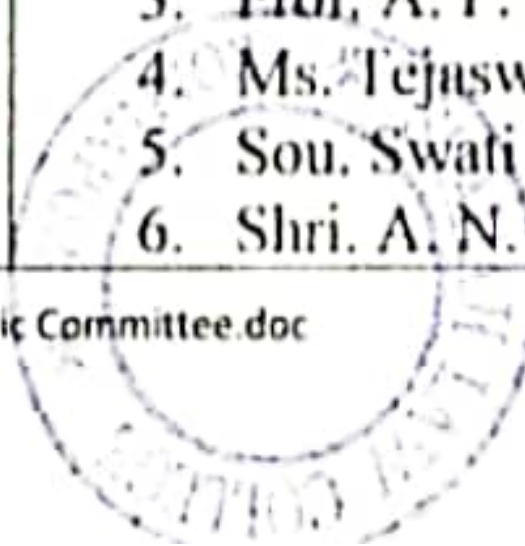

The agenda, minutes and Action Taken Report are to be documented with official signatures and maintained in the allotted book very neat manner in a retrievable format.

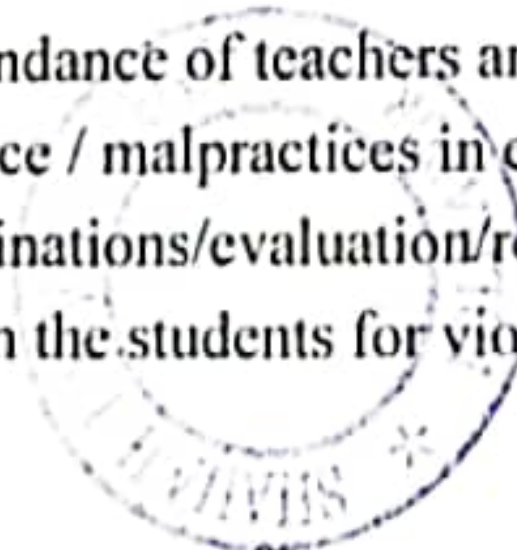

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

Trafficking of women for the purpose of sexual exploitation, prostitution, forced labour, slavery and servitude is a worldwide phenomenon unfolding by leaps and bounds every day. Many International Conventions supported by National Legislations and Policies are put in place by the national and international communities to curb this ever-growing menace. However, the ground realities narrate different stories. Of the agencies tasked to ameliorate the conditions of women, National Commission for Women (NCW) is a front runner. Having understood that the lack of sensitization among the stakeholders about the phenomenon of trafficking has resulted in perpetuation of this crime, the NCW has encouraged the institutions to shoulder their responsibility in disseminating the presence and importance of legal framework and rehabilitative schemes for the victims of the trafficking. The present seminar is one of such joint ventures between National Commission for Women and Shahaji Law College, Kolhapur.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SEMINAR

The seminar is intended to achieve the following objectives

1. To trace out the causes of women trafficking from the perspectives of law, social sciences and perceived social norms.
2. To understand the trauma, helplessness and loneliness of the victims of women trafficking.
3. To unearth the investigation predicament of police personnel in handling women trafficking.
4. To assess the adequacy of legal framework in India and the responsive schemes.
5. To review the constructive role played by National Commission for Women, other statutory bodies and NGOs in prevention of women trafficking.

SHAHAJI LAW COLLEGE

Shahaji Law College is one of the oldest Law colleges in the state of Maharashtra. His Highness Chhatrapati Rajaram Maharaj established the Council of Legal Education in 1933 under the auspices of which the 'Sykes Law College' was opened. INTRODUCTION

(a) Background Note of the subject matter of the Seminar/Workshop/Conferences

Trafficking of women for the purpose of sexual exploitation, prostitution, forced labour, slavery and servitude is a worldwide phenomenon unfolding by leaps and bounds every day. Many International Conventions supported by National Legislations and Policies are put in place by the national and international communities to curb this ever-growing menace. She has highlighted her experiences of working with American Peace Institute and Samhita international. She spoke on the areas such as

- Health issues of prostitutes
- Rehabilitation issues
- Basic rights for themselves
- Basic rights of children
- Policing predicaments in handling cases
- Identity issues like voting cards and Adhar Cards
- Social recognition/ denunciation
- Right to life and livelihood
- Reintegration with family and acceptance

She also projected as to how the student volunteers can bring change in the lives of trafficking victims. She also highlighted the intern work carried by the NGO. In response to the call, the three lady students from Shahaji Law college, expressed the desire to work with NGO in summer for two months. They have given preliminary approval to work with NGO

Professor, Uday Sawant, Principal of Bharati Vidyapeeth New Law College, Kolhapur, chaired the session. In his address, he concurred with the narration of the speaker and observed that, the given the enormity of women trafficking, the role of NGO comes first in handling the such cases. He also counted the advantages of working through NGO route, such as anonymity, friendliness, openness, feel like one, confidence and trust etc. He promised to extend the help of his law college in ameliorating the conditions of sex workers and prevention of human trafficking.

PART THIRD- THE DETAILS OF TECHNICAL SESSIONS

Post lunch the technical sessions began. There were four parallel sessions in four different halls. The technical sessions were arranged on the basis of the themes of the papers. Each parallel session was chaired by resourceful person. Each hall had the 12 to 15 paper presenters depending upon the mode of presentation. The presentations were scientifically mixed on basis of nature of presentation, i.e., presentation of faculty, researcher scholars, workers in NGO and students. The presentation was also classified on the themes so as to create a known and conducive exercise.

The paper presentation session was for about 2 hours. The high tea break followed.

THE VALEDICTORY FUNCTION

Prof. (Dr.) Kaushik Raval, Director, school of law, Gujarat University, was the chief guest. Hon'ble Sou. Rajanitai Magadum, President, Council of Education, hon'ble Shri. Prasad Kamat, Vice-President, Council of Education, Hon'ble Adv. V.N. Patil, Member, Council of Education were the guests of honour.

Dr. Praveen Patil, Convener of seminar read the day long proceedings. He narrated in brief the day long deliberation and highlights of the plenary sessions.

In his address, Prof. (Dr.) Kaushik Raval addressed the issue of women trafficking extensively from the perspective of human rights violation and moral compass. He referred to the day long deliberations and concluded that 'the problem of women trafficking is a subtle phenomenon where the multiple plyers are involved including the near and dear ones. The trafficking is equally with consent, though, it may not be in same proportion as it is without consent'. The existing legal regime has proved to be inefficient firstly in understanding the process of women trafficking and secondly the methodology to curb and circumscribe the trafficking. He wished the Bill of 2018 proposed at the national level is passed with necessary changes as soon as it may be.

He expressed his gratitude to the college and NCW for collaborating for a cause. He declared the seminar as a grand success and intellectual feast.

Few participants expressed their opinion about the seminar. Of them, Felix, a doctoral candidate from Kenya, and Miss. Parikrama Khot, post graduate from Cardiff University, Wales, United Kingdom, expressed their opinion about the success of the seminar. Both were international students though the seminar was national one. Their presence, their day long observation of seminar and presentation of paper by them upheld the success of the seminar.

3. OBSERVATIONS

The seminar turned out to be the platform for exploring the enormity of women trafficking and exploitation. The seminar unearthed the magnitude and dimensions of women trafficking in particular and human trafficking in general. The grassroot experiences of resource persons of the seminar and inquisitive participation of the participants made it meaningful exercise. The students who are still in the leaning of law were able to understand the nuances and delicacies of the law enforcement mechanism. The ground zero workers also understood the applicability and dimensions of application of law, which factor, they seem, were struggling to understand. The law enforcement agencies and interpreter of laws also had a chance to understand and appreciate the predicaments of ground level workers. The paper presenter put forth various dimensions of trafficking from social, political, economic, Legal, moral, and philosophical dimensions.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS/ACTION POINTS

Those relating to Local Administration and/or its agencies

1. District Anti-Trafficking Committee shall be established at every district level to prevent, rescue, and protect victims of trafficking and to provide medical care, psychological assistance and need-based rehabilitation of victims

2. The Government shall provide adequate resources to the District Anti-Trafficking Committee for carrying out the above-mentioned objectives.
3. District Anti-Trafficking Committee shall be autonomous and should have its own funding and powers to rehabilitate financially the victims of trafficking
4. Special courts shall be designated to handle and dispose of trafficking cases with time limitation of reporting, enquiring and disposing of the matters.
5. District legal services authority shall be key player in the prevention of trafficking and rehabilitation of victims

Those relating to State Administration and/or its agencies

1. The appropriate Government shall establish a State Anti – Trafficking Committee to oversee prevention of prevention of trafficking and rehabilitation of victims
2. State Anti –Trafficking Committee shall have the powers to develop effective networking and linkages with local non-Governmental organizations for specialized services and technical assistance like vocational training, education, healthcare, nutrition, mental health intervention, drug de-addiction and legal aid services.

3. vulnerability mapping of the State shall be undertaken dividing the areas of trafficking as (1) sensitive, (2) prone and (3) fallen. The programs and schemes of rehabilitation and preventive steps shall then be structured accordingly.
4. The Protection Homes and Rehabilitation Homes shall be maintained either directly or through voluntary organizations or non-Governmental organizations by the state governments for the victims or any person rescued from the trafficking
5. The state Government shall provide adequate funds at the disposal of the District Anti-Trafficking Committee for prevention of trafficking and rehabilitation of victims.


Those relating to Govt. of India and/or its agencies

1. Comprehensive law covering every aspect of human trafficking shall be brought forth immediately. The Trafficking of Persons (Prevention, Protection and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2018, as introduced in the Lok Sabha (Bill No. 89 of 2018) is ideally drafted which may be reintroduced with minor changes regarding presumption of offences and gradation of punishments.
2. Since the trafficking runs in racket and closed net, protection of witnesses and whistle blower shall be assured
3. National Anti-Trafficking Relief and Rehabilitation Committee as was suggested by 2018 Bill shall be retained and reintroduced

4. The Bill of 2018 had a great clause of "Rehabilitation not to be contingent on criminal proceedings" where the approach is rehabilitation based rather the conviction remains. Such rehabilitative approach shall be underscored
5. Rehabilitation fund at national level is "a must provision" in order to make the law rehabilitative in nature apart from being punitive
6. General principles of criminal laws like, no bail in heinous offences, heavy fine, forfeiture of property, confiscation of gratification and proceeds of crime etc. shall be retained.
7. Facilitative national and international institutional apparatus shall be created to repatriate the transboundary victims of the trafficking
8. Comprehensive education policy shall be adopted through media sensitization and appropriate syllabus inclusion schools and colleges
9. NGOs and volunteers shall be appropriately rewarded and at national level for their role in the prevention of trafficking
10. Economic inability to bear owns own life shall never result in the bartering of skin and will. The govt shall endeavor in uplifting the living standards of people in general and vulnerable in particular.
