## College Policy document for scholarship

The institution has developed transparent and prompt mechanism for providing various scholarships to needy and deserving students every year.

The institution follows following methodology for issuing scholarships.

### Scholarships and Freeship by the Government:

Step 1: The college issues notice to all students of different streams inviting them to fill online application form for the scholarship on MAHADBT portal every year after completing the admission process.

Step 2: After due notice to the students, class Mentors of the concerned classes gives information about various scholarships available, and also, they encourage eligible students to apply and avail respective scholarship.



Step 3: To create awareness amongst the students, boards have been displayed containing information related to the various scholarships.

Step 3: After completing the deadline to submit online application for the scholarship, the college office verifies the filled details of the students. They inform all students about the online status of their application for the scholarship.

Step 4: The students are informed of queries, if any, in the application and guided regarding further action to be taken.

Step 5: The institution forwards the proposal for scholarship of all eligible students to concern authorities in online mode.

Step 6: After completing due formalities, the Central or State Government as the case may be, disburses the scholarship amount directly in the Bank account of all beneficiaries.

The College has deposited that amount in Fixed Deposit and utilising the interest on it as a financial assistance by the College to the students who stands First, Second & Third in their class every year.

(४) संचालक, उच्च शिक्षण, महाराष्ट्र राज्य, पुणे यांनी प्रत्येक योजनेकरीता राष्ट्रीयकृत बँकेत एक संयुक्त खाते उघडून त्याद्वारे लाभार्थी विद्यार्थ्यांना शिष्यवृत्ती राज्यस्तरीय DBT पोर्टल मार्फत अदा करण्याची कार्यवाही करावी. वर नमूद खात्याव्यतिरिक्त इतर कोणतेही खाते जिल्हा/तालुका/विभागस्तरावर ठेवण्यात येऊ नये.

(६) सदर प्रयोजनार्थ माहिती तंत्रज्ञान संचालनालयाकडून केंद्रीभूत थेट लाभ हस्तांतरण पोर्टल विकसित करण्यात येत असून, यासंदर्भात वेळोवेळी मार्गदर्शक सूचना स्वतंत्रपणे निर्गमित करण्याची कार्यवाही करण्यात येईल. शिष्यवृत्ती/आर्थिक सहाय्य योजनेसंदर्भातील अर्ज करण्यापासून शिष्यवृत्ती/आर्थिक सहाय्याची रक्कम लाभार्थी विद्यार्थ्यांच्या आधार संलग्नित बँक खात्यात जमा करण्यापर्यंतच्या सर्व प्रक्रियेसाठी राज्यस्तरीय DBT पोर्टलचा वापर करणे अनिवार्य राहिल.

From time to time, complaints have been made to Govern-  
ment of delay in the award and payment of the State Government  
Merit Scholarship in Arts, Science, Commerce and Law Colleges.  
Government has, therefore, carefully considered the question of  
delay in the award and payment of these scholarships.  
Delay is inevitable in view of the fact that the award of the  
State scholarships can be finalised only after the Government of  
India Merit Scholarships under the National Scholarships Scheme are finalised,  
and the students covered under the National Scholarships Scheme  
are also repeated in the list of applicants for the State Govern-  
ment Merit Scholarships referred to above. Only those students  
who secure the Government of India scholarships are consi-  
dered for the award of the State Scholarships. Another reason for the  
delay is due to the present practice of having the scholarship bills  
of the students in non-Government Colleges submitted to  
the Director of Education's office monthly, in arrears.

In a view to minimising delay in the award and payment of  
State Government Scholarships, Government is pleased to direct that the  
Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, should place the  
bills of the scholarships for the whole year in one lump sum,  
at the disposal of the Principals of non-Government Arts,  
Science, Commerce and Law Colleges in this State for disbursement  
in arrears, to the respective scholars in those colleges,  
who have been selected by the Director of Education, under the rules  
of the Government Resolution, Education & Social Welfare  
Department, No. SCH.1063-U, dated 4-6-64. This should be done after  
finalising the State list of Scholars. As soon as the Heads of the  
Colleges receive the amounts of the scholarships they should  
make lump sum payment of the amount due to scholar(s) upto the month  
prior to that in which the amount is received and thereafter,  
pay in arrears. For example, if the amount is received in  
October for a scholarship due for June to October should be paid in lump  
sum in October and for November in December and so on. The  
Principals should make the payments regularly and intimate to the  
Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, before the 15th of  
the month the dates on which the payments have been made. They  
should simultaneously send to the Director of Education,



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Maharashtra State, Poona, the receipts from the sum of the scholarship amounts. The Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, should prescribe a suitable form for the relevant information by the Principals.

3. Accordingly, rule 9 of the rules accompanying Resolution, Education & Social Welfare Department, dated 4-6-64 should be revised as under:-

"The full amounts of scholarships due to the Principals for the entire year should be paid by the Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, in advance, in one lump sum. Principals of the non-Government institutions concerned should monthly in arrears, to the scholars in those institutions who have been selected by the Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, in accordance with these rules. The payments should be made after finalising the State list of scholars. As soon as the Principals of the institutions receive the amounts of the scholarships, they should make lump sum payment of the amount due to the scholars for the month previous to that in which the amount is received, monthly in arrears. For example, if the amount for the month of November, scholarship due for June to October should be paid in lump sum during November and for November in December. The payment should be made by the Principals subject to the satisfactory progress, etc. of the scholars. The Principals should make the payment regularly and send to the Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, before the 15th of every month a schedule in the prescribed form indicating the date on which the payment of the scholarships have been made. They should also send to the Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, the receipts from the scholars in respect of the scholarships.

In the case of Government Colleges, the Principals should draw the scholarships monthly on bills signed by the Principals and the Director of Education, Maharashtra State, Poona, should pay the amount drawn. However, the payment should be made only after the State list of scholars is finalised. The amount due to the scholars upto the month previous to that in which the amount is received should be paid in lump sum and thereafter the payments should be made monthly in arrears as in the case of non-Government Colleges."

4. These orders issue with the concurrence of the Secretary to the Department vide its unofficial reference No. 34964/64 dated the 29th October 1964.

The question of revising rules for award of Government Open Merit Scholarships in Arts, Science, Commerce and Law Colleges is under the active consideration of Government. Accordingly draft revised rules were submitted to Government under this office D.O. Letter No. 303-1074/31447/22 dated 26th March 1974. A reference in this connection is solicited to Government Letter No. 303-1074-20995-5 dated 15th June 1974 under which clarifications on certain points referred to in the above letter have been called for. However, before modifying the draft rules already prepared in view of observations it is necessary to take into consideration the following points :

Change in the Pattern of Education :

As per Government decision the new pattern of school education (10 + 2 + 3) has been accepted and accordingly the revised syllabus for standards XI to XII has been introduced in the year 1972-73. The first batch as per the ten year's pattern will be appearing for the S.C.C. (Xth) Examinations in March 1975. Simultaneously as per the old pattern students studying standard 11th during the year 1974-75 will also appear for the S.C.C. Examination in March 1975 which will be conducted as per the old syllabus. Thus in June 1975 one batch of students as per old syllabus will go to the Pre-Degree class in the existing colleges. The batches of students passing the S.C.C. Examination as per the revised syllabus will join the XIth Class in June 1975. The Government Open Merit Scholarships are for XIth Class and as such the students joining XIth Class after passing the S.C.C. Examinations will also have to be considered for award of Government Open Merit Scholarships.

No. of sets of scholarships :

Government

During the year 1973-74 there were 1000 sets of scholarships in addition Government under their sanction. Education Department No. 304-1072-S, dated 11 January 1974 have sanctioned 208 additional sets of scholarships. At present there are in all 1208 sets of scholarships available for being distributed to the students in Arts, Science, Commerce and Law Colleges as per the existing rules. The distribution of 1208 sets is as indicated below :

The value of the scholarships is Rs. 30 per month and the scholarships are payable for a period of four years except in case of Law students. These scholarships are not available either for medical or for engineering course. In case it is decided to award Government Open Merit Scholarships to the students studying in Standard 11th either in classes opened in Secondary Schools or Colleges an equal number of scholarships will have to be newly introduced from June 1975 extending the 56 scholarships awarded to Law students. Total 1153 scholarships will be awarded to the students in standard 11th on the same basis as at present followed for award of these scholarships to the students studying in Pre-Degree Arts, Science or Commerce Classes. These 1153 scholarships will be in addition to the 1153 fresh scholarships that will be awarded to the students studying in Pre-Degree classes of Arts, Science or Commerce in June 1975 as per existing procedure.

Financial Implications : In case the proposal for introducing 1153 scholarships afresh during the year 1975-76 for students who will be joining Standard 11th after passing the B.S.L. Examination (Xth) as per revised syllabus in June 1975 the additional expenditure is estimated at 1153 X 120 = Rs. 1,38,360. This amount of additional expenditure on payment of scholarships to 1153 students in Arts, Science and Commerce groups in standard 11th during 1975-76 will have to be provided for in addition to the normal provisions made for fresh awards and continuance of Government Open Merit Scholarships already sanctioned during the year 1975-76.

Award of Scholarships during year 1976-77 :  
In June 1976 the Pre-Degree class in colleges is likely to be abolished in view of the introduction of this class in standard Secondary schools or colleges.





as the case may be. During the year 1976-77 the Government Open Merit Scholarships which are at present awarded to the students in Pre-Degree class will be awarded to the students in the 11th class so that continuity will be achieved during this year. Thus it will be seen that the impact of Revised pattern of Education (i.e. 10+2+3) ultimately would be in receiving practically the same sets of scholarships i.e. 1153 for Arts, Science and Commerce and 55 for Law. However, the tenure of the 1153 scholarships would be for a period of 5 years i.e. two years for the Higher Secondary stage and three years for the Degree course. Instead of for a period of four years as per the existing pattern.

In view of the position stated above it is requested that Government be pleased to consider the above proposal and accord their sanction for awarding 1153 scholarships to students in Standard class of 11th and 12th secondary class for the degree course of Arts, Science and Commerce and to the additional amount of Rs. 55 for Law during the year 1976-76. The only modification that will be required would be to award 55 for the existing 1153 sets for Arts, Science and Commerce colleges will be for extending the tenure of the existing sets by one year only, out of which two years (two years for higher secondary and three years for Degree course). If the above proposal is approved, changes in the draft rules already submitted to Government will have to be made before finalising the same on receipt of Government orders. Immediate approval of the draft rules already submitted to Government, and a fresh proposal for revision of award of Government Open Merit scholarships will be submitted to Government.
