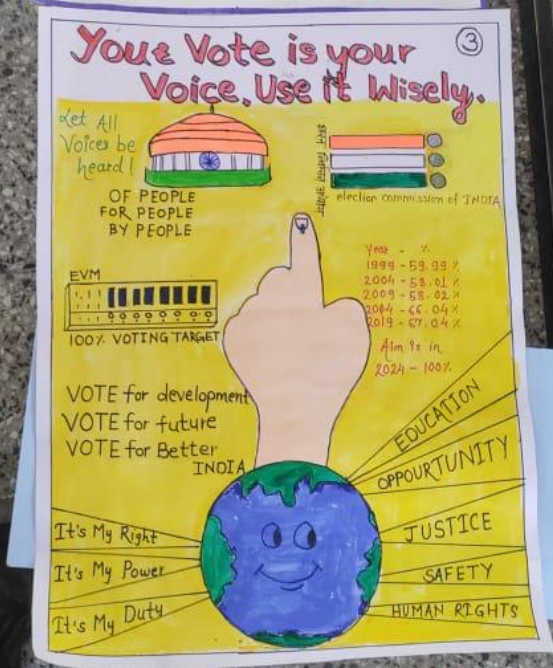


7.1.9. –Sensitization of students and employees of the institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities to citizens.
